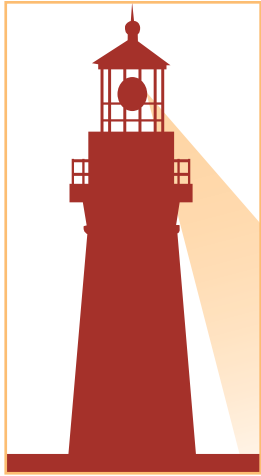


# Western Arkansas Counseling & Guidance Center



Western Arkansas Counseling and Guidance Center offers a wide range of counseling services and programs. Professional mental health services are offered by a competent and qualified staff who are committed to treating psychiatric, behavioral and emotional disorders.

Since 1972, the Guidance Center has helped thousands of people. Our network of behavioral healthcare services is available in the communities of Crawford, Franklin, Logan, Polk, Scott and Sebastian counties in western Arkansas.

Our team of mental health professionals include board-certified psychiatrists, licensed psychologists and counselors, clinical social workers, mental health paraprofessionals, and advanced nurse practitioners.

## How Can We Serve You?

Our primary mission is to offer mental health treatment, prevention and education for children, adolescents and adults. Services include outpatient counseling, crisis intervention, psychiatric services, psychological assessment and medication management.

At the Guidance Center, we view each client as a unique individual. Your needs will be matched

with a counselor who is qualified to assist you with your specific needs. We also have bilingual staff members for our Hispanic clients; interpreters are available upon request.

If necessary, our clients are referred to our medical staff for medication management and consultation. This service is only available to our clients who are also receiving counseling services.

## Specialty Outpatient Services

The Guidance Center offers several specialty programs and services. **L.E.A.P.** is a language enrichment program for preschoolers who have difficulty with speech articulation.

**School-Based Services** program provides counseling for children and adolescents in the public schools. Our therapists work with school administrators and teachers to facilitate the convenience of counseling at your child's school.

**Group Psychotherapy**, another treatment option, is offered for depression, anxiety, co-occurring disorders, anger management and grief.

In addition to regular therapy, adults with serious mental illness have the **NEW Beginnings Program**. This Day Treatment program offers our clients specialized group therapy and a psychosocial environment for treatment and support.

The **Psychological Assessment Clinic** is a testing program. Psychological tests are available in the following areas: personality, forensic, intellectual assessment, SSI qualification, PTSD, ADHD, depression, and many more.

**ChristianCare** is a Christ-centered counseling option. This group of counselors adhere to a personal faith commitment established by the *Christian Association for Psychological Studies*.

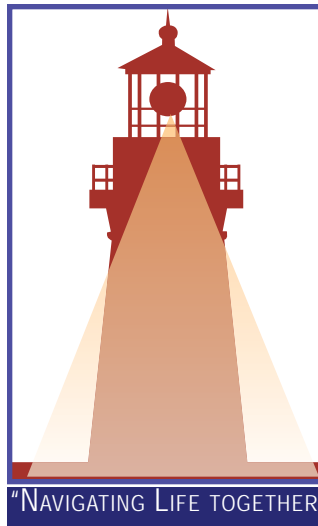
