For your convenience, please use this list as you prepare for your stay at our facility.

What not to bring:

- Bedding, linens, towels, iPads/tablets, laptops, gaming systems, perfume/cologne, aerosol spray, snacks/drinks, and meals.
- Weapons, illicit drugs and non-prescribed medications are not allowed.
- Products containing alcohol (perfumes, nail polish remover, mouthwash, hand sanitizer, etc.).
- Provocative or otherwise inappropriate clothing (cut-offs, spaghetti straps, mini-skirts, short shorts, see through clothes, etc.)

What to bring (2 bag limit per client):

Note: The amount of clothing is to not exceed 1 bag; all other items must fit into the 2nd bag. Please have weather appropriate clothing and plan to switch out clothing as the seasons change. Outdoor activities are a part of the program.

- **Clothing:** Enough clothing for 1 week; washer and dryer is available; 8 Shirts/Blouses, Jeans/Pants/Skirts in Combination, Underwear/Socks/Bras, Pajamas/Robe/Slippers, coat/jacket, gloves, hat, Sneakers/flats/shower shoes.
- **Toiletries:** Basic toiletries are provided, however, you may bring the products you desire such as: hair brush, comb, shampoo, deodorant, soap (bar or bottle), toothbrush, toothpaste, feminine hygiene, shaving cream (razors will be provided). Products must be in a clear plastic bag and separate from the 2 bag limit mentioned above.
- **Medications:** Clients should bring only a 30 day supply of medications (medications must be in their pharmacy provided prescription bottles/packaging).
- **Nicotine products:** Nicotine use is permitted. You must bring your own unopened cigarettes, disposable unopened vapes, and unopened chewing tobacco to the facility because you will not be able to purchase it once admitted. Family members will be permitted to drop off tobacco products during designated times. Federal law prohibits the use of tobacco products to individuals under the age of 21 years.

Allowed (must also fit in the 2 bag limit):

- Stamps, notebooks, envelopes, pens/colored pencils, appropriate books, novels and magazines, family Photos.
- Maximum of \$40 cash for individual client use.

Provided:

- Bedding, toiletries, basic cleaning supplies, laundry detergents, furniture, basic hygiene products, snacks, meals.
- Appropriate and limited over-the-counter medications (i.e. tylenol) in unopened bottles. We will have basic OTC meds available

Additional Information:
